Tiziana Soudani, an independent producer for Amka Films Productions SA, is a member of ACE Atelier Cinéma Européen, of the Swiss Film Academy, of the European Film Academy (EFA), of the board of directors of the Swiss Film Foundation and is an advisor for the Film Fund & Commission of the BLS – Business Location Südtirol/Alto Adige.

In 2013 she won the Ciak d'Oro Best Producer award for the film *L'intervallo* directed by Leonardo Di Costanzo and the Swiss Republic and Canton Ticino prize for Best Producer at the Locarno Film Festival.

Over the years its productions and co-productions have won many prizes and honorable mentions: in 1998 Best Swiss Film for *Walo Fendo* by Mohammed Soudani; 9 David di Donatello awards for *Pane e tulipani* by Silvio Soldini in 2000; the Controcorrente Prize at the 2003 Venice Film Festival for *Vodka Lemon* by Hiner Saleem; 15 awards, ranging from the Fipresci Prize at the 2012 Venice Film Festival to the 2013 David di Donatello for Best First Film for *L'intervallo* by Leonardo Di Costanzo; and most recently the Grand Prix at the 2014 Cannes Film Festival for *Le meraviglie* by Alice Rohrwacher.
